

IN THE WORLD

According to international university rankings in recent years, the University of Maribor has been named among the top 3 percent of the world's best universities.

According to the Academic Ranking of World Universities (known as Shanghai Ranking), the University of Maribor has been ranked among the world's top 600 universities, whereas according to the Times Higher Education Rankings, it has been ranked among the top 300 European universities or the top 1000 universities in the world.



Did you know that Slovenia has more than 80 ski areas?

In 2019, the University of Maribor was ranked among the top 200 universities according to the Times Europe Teaching Rankings, which focuses on assessing the quality of higher education and learning environments. It was the only Slovenian university included in the Times Europe Teaching Rankings 2019.

In 2017, the University of Maribor was named among the best ranked universities in the field of MATHEMATICS.





In 2017 and 2018, the University of Maribor was named among the best ranked universities in the fields of PHYSICS & ASTRONOMY.

The University of Maribor has won the StudyPortals "Global Student Satisfaction Awards 2019" in the "Overall Satisfaction" category.



) Successfully completed appropriate secondary education.


) Completed procedure for the recognition of secondary-school certificates obtained abroad.

The decision on recognition of foreign education for the purpose of further education at the University of Maribor is a mandatory document for the candidate's enrolment application to be complete.


