Appeals to the Student Appeals Committee of the University of Maribor

The Student Appeals Committee of the University of Maribor decides on appeals filed by students against decisions issued by university bodies and bodies of its faculties, in cases concerning student rights and obligations, where no other appeal body is designated by regulations or the Statute of the University of Maribor.

The Committee primarily handles the following types of appeals:

- Appeals submitted by applicants due to alleged irregularities in the admission procedure, after receiving the decision on the outcome of the procedure (Article 84 of the UM Statute).
- Appeals submitted by students against faculty decisions regarding academic progression, repetition of a year, or extension of student status (Articles 85, 121, and 214 of the UM Statute, and the Guidelines for the Evaluation of Student Requests and Justified Reasons in accordance with Articles 85, 121, and 214 of the UM Statute).
- Appeals against faculty decisions regarding continuation or completion of studies following an interruption, and appeals related to re-enrolment after withdrawal (Article 123 of the UM Statute).
- Other appeals submitted by students who believe that their rights have been violated, in matters not under the jurisdiction of another appeal body (Article 221 of the UM Statute – Protection of Student Rights).

The Statute of the University of Maribor and the *Guidelines for the Evaluation of Student Requests and Justified Reasons in accordance with Articles 85, 121, and 214 of the UM Statute* are available in the UM Document Centre (available only in Slovene).

How to Submit an Appeal:

- Appeals concerning the outcome of the admission procedure must be submitted within the deadline specified in the decision, via the eVŠ portal.
- Appeals against decisions of the faculty study affairs committee must be submitted within eight (8) days of the decision being served. The appeal must be submitted to the body that issued the decision. If the appeal is mistakenly filed with the second-instance body, it will immediately forward it to the first-instance body.

- in person at the faculty student affairs office, or
- in written form at the University of Maribor reception or official filing office (Slomškov trg 15, 2000 Maribor).
